Candidates may be nominated to serve on the Reclamation District No. 1000 Board of Trustees (RD1000) for a 4-year term to commence December 13, 2024, through a petition process. The election will be held on November 12, 2024. RD1000 board elections are governed by the California Water Code, Section 50730 *et seq.*, and the RD 1000-specific requirements of Water Code Section 50780 *et seq.* Questions should be emailed to **Administrative Services Manager, Joleen Gutierrez,** at jgutierrez@rd1000.org for a response.

Potential Candidates

For a candidate to be nominated and placed on the ballot for trustee; 5 valid signatures from applicable landowners must be obtained for the candidate and submitted to RD1000. Signatures will be validated by District Staff.

- **Step 1**: Download the RD1000 Nomination Petition Forms from the RD1000 website, <u>www.rd1000.org</u>. You must use the RD1000 Nomination Petition forms.
- **Step 2: Before** obtaining signatures, the candidate must ensure any petition signatures are received by eligible voters within the District as deemed by Water Code 50780.10. Signatures that cannot be verified will be deemed ineligible.
- **Step 3:** Nomination Petition signatures may be collected and filed with RD1000 between August 29 and September 19, 2024.
- **Step 4: After** obtaining signatures, complete and sign the Affidavit of Circular, Affidavit of Nominee, and California Jurat. Your signature must be notarized.
- **Step 5:** Candidate Statements (optional) and Candidate Form 700 forms must be filed with the District by September 19, 2024.
- Step 6: Nomination Petitions with original signatures of eligible petition signers must be submitted to the District Office at the address listed above (Attn: Joleen Gutierrez) NO LATER THAN 4:30 pm on Thursday, September 19, 2024.

Trustee Candidates

• A candidate for the RD1000 Board of Trustees position must be a resident landowner as defined by the California Water Code 50780.12

Nomination Petition Signers

- A Nomination Petition Signer must be an eligible voter, a landowner within the boundaries of RD1000, or a designated proxy, as defined by California Water Code Sec 50780
- Nomination Petition Signers must furnish an original signature and complete address (street address, city, state, zip) For verification purposes, a telephone number is also requested.
